The therapist will provide outpatient individual, family, and/or group therapy to adult individuals and families. Requires MO licensure as LCSW, LPC, or LMFT.

Essential Duties

- Complete comprehensive assessment and treatment planning for clients using electronic record
- Provide evidence-based individual, couple, and family psychotherapy
- Coordinate with other providers as appropriate
- Document all clinical transactions in accordance with agency policy and procedure
- Attend weekly counseling team and all staff meetings. Provide case presentations at team meetings
- Periodic after hours on-call (on rotation) and some evening work

- An interest in working collaboratively with JFS counseling team, staff, and community partners
- At least two years of mental health experience
- Warm, kind, and approachable
- Strong assessment and treatment planning skills and knowledge of DSM 5
